



PLACEMENT REPORT 2016-17

Shaheed Sukhdev College of Business Studies (CBS) is a premier undergraduate management college under the aegis of the University of Delhi (DU) offering Bachelor of Management Studies (BMS), BBA (Financial Investment Analysis) and B. Sc. (H) Computer Science. The admission in BMS and BBA (FIA) is through a highly competitive Joint Admission Test (DU JAT) followed by rounds of Group Discussion and Personal Interview with an intake ratio of 120:1.

The Placement Season 2016-17 saw the participation of 48 companies making 125 offers and counting. Bain Capability Centre was the largest recruiters with 10 offers. The average package amounted to INR 5.5 LPA while the highest package offered was INR 16.5 LPA. The season saw 3 companies from the league of the Big 4 namely EY, KPMG and Deloitte. Other reputed names such as The Boston Consulting Group, DE Shaw, Duff & Phelps, Futures First, Axis Risk Consulting, EIVA, Samagra Governance and Mazars also became a part of the season.
